A pleasant holiday wine that pairs well with sweeter food. A delightful pool wine when served well-chilled.**2008 Brucher Monterey County Chardonnay**

Color Light golden straw.

Nose Pears, green apples with a hint of oak.**Taste** Green apple fruit, round mouth feel, well-balanced, multi-layered, medium long finish.**General** A versatile wine. A pleasant aperitif as well as a delicious compliment to fish, chicken, and other light meat or vegetable dishes.**2009 Golden Bear Santa Barbara County Chardonnay**

Color Light straw.

\$174

Nose Apple, oak, vanilla, and spice, with a tropical hint.**Taste** Round and fruity entry. Rich and complex with a long, clean finish.**General** Seductively balanced. Serve with light fowl and other mild dishes. Very pleasant as a cool and fruity aperitif.**2008 Brucher Edna Valley Pinot Noir**

Color Dark ruby.

Nose Toasty oak, strawberry, and a trace of cranberry.**Taste** Bright strawberry and blackberry fruit. Lively balance with lots of sweet oak. Medium structure. Soft, pleasant mouth feel. Long, pleasant, fruity finish.**General** A pleasant aperitif or stand-alone wine. Wonderful with oily fish and light meats, mild cheeses, and creamy pasta sauces. Serve with any delicate and complex foods.**2007 Golden Bear Santa Barbara County Pinot Noir**

Color Dark, dense, ruby red.

\$222

Nose Gravelly cherry and strawberry with a little oak.**Taste** Dense flavors of blackberry and oak. Big-bodied and balanced. Nice, long finish.**General** Rich and bold style of Pinot Noir to accompany roasted beef, vegetables, and potatoes. This is not a frivolous wine!**2007 Golden Bear Santa Barbara County Syrah**

Color Inky, dark plum.

\$204

Nose Bright, pleasant, light plum and vanilla with a trace of black pepper.**Taste** Bright, fruity entry which mellows into a round balanced wine which fills the mouth with a meaty texture. Soft, yet bold with a fairly long finish.**General** Not an aperitif! A serious wine meant to accompany food – especially game, spicy and smoked or acidic dishes.**2006 Brucher San Luis Obispo County Cabernet Sauvignon**

Color Very dark dense black ruby.

\$204

Nose Oak, blackberry and a hint of leather.**Taste** Sweet oak, blackberries, leather and a pinch of tobacco, rich mouth feel with ample tannins; balanced with a long fruit and oak finish.**General** A “big” rich wine with plenty of body and sufficient tannins and flavor to match rich cheese, meat, and game dishes.**2004 Brucher Golden Bear Santa Barbara County Cabernet Port**

Color Very dark ruby red.

\$288

Nose Enticing red fruits.**Taste** Red fruit flavors led by dark red cherries.**General** A delightful Cabernet Port with a mild, enticing nose and a finish that lingers long in the senses. A wonderful stand-alone dessert wine, or can be enhanced with dark chocolates.*10% discount on case purchase. Mixed okay.*

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
